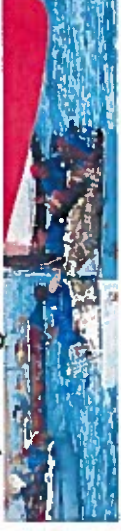


On Saturday, July 22, 2017, I will be going to watch the sailboats get ready to race to Mackinac Island.
